We're doing a study to look at how workers are doing since the pandemic and would like to access your group's postings.

We're looking for groups with...



social workers, social care staff, and community and voluntary sector workers working in England.



We want to highlight your lived experience to respond more quickly to work-related challenges.

What to expect if your group admin grants access

Every day or so, a **Group Admin** will use a **secure automated system already on WhatsApp** to collect new posts from your group and send to a secure email where another secure system will put together all the posts ('data') from groups with the same kind of workers, immediately **delete all identifying information** (e.g., names, placenames, images, links) and **transform the data into numbers**. The numbers will be used to create a simple graph showing overall trends in resilience, resistance and burnout. Admins will receive an expression of thanks for their time.



No one needs to do anything different. Members can **post as normal about anything** on their minds... **researchers see only the graphs**. We will provide a notice about this research to post on the group before, during and after the research.



Researchers and others will **never see the actual posts or any identifying information** because they **are immediately deleted forever**. All anyone will ever see is a simple graph of trends in resilience, resistance and burnout.



The wider study is also looking at the economic impacts of not supporting workers; however, this request relates only to amplifying your voices to show real time and emerging trends in resilience, resistance and burnout.
